Shooter of the Year will be back for 2019! Overall high point shooter in each division (by shooting style, age and gender) will named Shooter of the Year for that division and awarded a custom shirt. Shooters must shoot 4 of 5 tournaments in 2019 to be eligible for this award. Eligible tournaments are Southwest Indoor Sectional, State Indoor, State Field, State International and State Classic. Since each tournament has different maximum points earned, overall placings will be based on a point system determined by how a shooter placed in each tournament.
