

Duel in the Desert Arizona Team Trials October 16, 2016

The **Duel in the Desert** is a team competition between Arizona, California, and Baja California. This year Arizona is hosting the Duel in the Desert at the Ben Avery FITA Range. Each team consists of 24 members: 6 male and female recurve shooters and 6 male and female compound shooters. In each division noted above, the top scoring shooters at the Duel Trials will earn a spot on the Arizona team. There is no age requirement to qualify for a spot on the AZ team. In addition to determining team members, proceeds from the Trials will provide funds for the AZ Team shirts. Team members will receive their team shirt at no charge, but will pay their own entry fee and expenses for the Duel competition. People qualifying for the team must commit to compete on the Arizona team, November 12-13, 2016.

The format of the Duel in the Desert is as follows:

How points are earned by the teams: A maximum of 3 points is earned per end per target based on score. The team with the most points at the end of the shoot wins and earns possession of the traveling trophy for one year until the winner of the next Duel is determined. Along with the travelling trophy, awards will be given to the top shooters in the four divisions.

Saturday Nov. 12. Archers will shoot 24 ends of three arrows at 70 meters on the 122cm FITA face.

Sunday November 13. Archers will shoot a metric 900 round: 30 arrows at 60, 50 and 40 meters on the 122cm FITA face.

At the Duel in the Desert, there will be a separate section of the field reserved for Open shooters. Awards will be given to the Open shooters by the styles, sex, and age.
