



2024 ABFAA State Champion Buckle Program

You spoke – We listened!

- No buy-in to participate. Just register and compete in a minimum of 5 ABFAA tournaments in 2024.
- Championship Buckles will be awarded to overall winners of each division, age group and gender. You compete against your peers. There must be a minimum of one competitor in the division. We will not combine divisions, age groups or genders.
- Must be a current NFAA member in good standing with Arizona residence to compete.

We are keeping it simple:

Five tournaments must be completed to qualify for the final Championship awards. Competition in more than one age group and shooting style division is allowed. Competitors may only compete in one age group and division per tournament. The exception is the State Indoor 3 Spot and the State Indoor 5 Spot because it offers multiple shooting times.

Archers must compete in 5 ABFAA State tournaments in the same shooting style to qualify. If an archer must move up an age group due to a birthday during the year, the archer will qualify in the age group they have the most entries in. For example, an archer turns 12 on October 31st and has competed in 4 tournaments. The archer competes in two more tournaments in the next higher age group. The archer's points will be applied to the division they competed in most of the year which will be Cub.

All age groups and genders will be offered for each shooting style.

Shooting Styles: Freestyle, Bowhunter Freestyle, Barebow Compound, Freestyle Limited Recurve, Barebow Recurve, Pro Freestyle (must possess valid NFAA Pro Card) Longbow, Traditional.

Age Groups: Cub 11 & under, Youth, 12-14, Young Adult, 15-17, Adult 18-49, Senior 50 -59, Silver Senior, 60-69, Master Senior 70+

Gender: Male, Female.

Qualifying Tournaments are listed below. (this is a tentative list and may change as the 2024 schedule is confirmed and set). A minimum of 5 tournaments will be offered.

- Points are awarded based on finishing position in the tournament. For example, 1 place is 1 point, 2nd place 2 points, 3rd place is 3 points, etc.
- Archers with the lowest total number of points at the end of the year will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- Top 5 tournament results are used to calculate winners.
- 1st-3rd place will receive award & recognition at the end of 2024 after completion of last tournament of 2024.
- 1st place finisher will receive a custom belt buckle. 2nd and third place winners will receive an award as determined by ABFAA Board.
- Rules may be modified, and tournaments dropped from or added to the schedule due to unforeseen circumstances.
